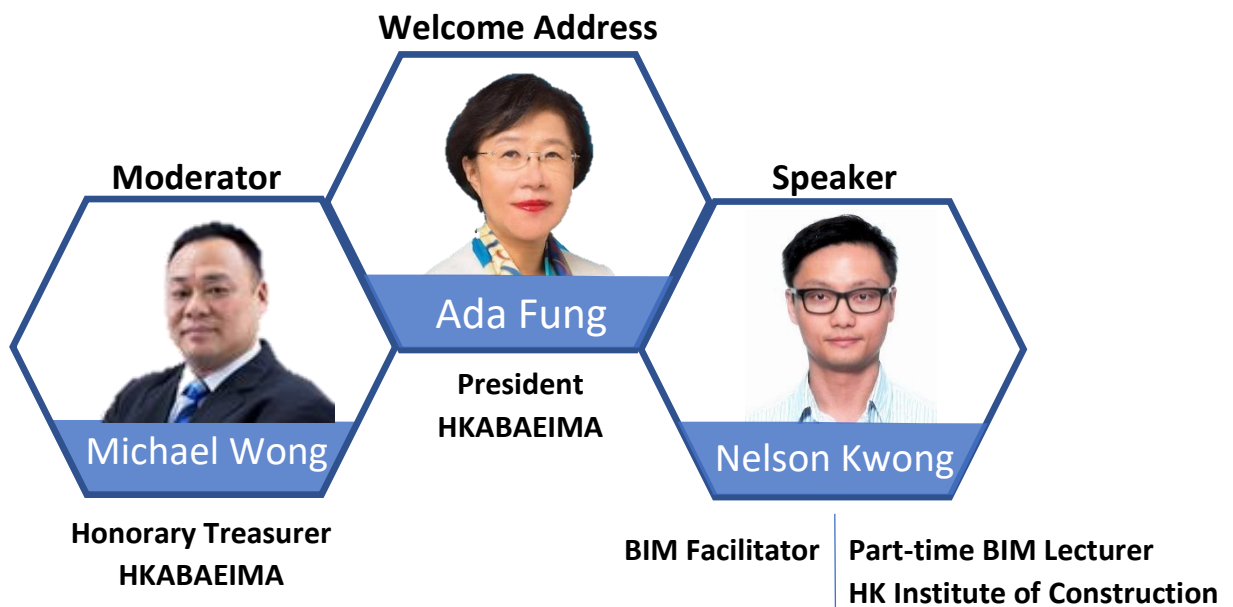

As early as 1452, Early Renaissance architect once raised the essence of architectural that architect delivers design intent and creative process to the entrusting party of project by blueprint. Freehand drawing blueprint technology is always the only option for the architect in the past six centuries. 21st century today, along with the fast development of computer technology and popularization of personal computers, CAD has already become a useful tool for construction. Till today, BIM is the process of developing and using 3D, digital representation of building project data throughout construction life cycle.

Speakers' Biography

Mr. Nelson Kwong, a committee of AIAB from 2016-2023, who is the BIM Facilitator for real estate development company of construction department. His team is responsible for supervising and managing the outsourced BIM Projects by BIM consultant companies. He is also in charge of internal BIM management, such as BIM Specification, Tender and Budget Setting Up, Research and Development, and Internal BIM Training. At the same time, he is a Part-time Lecturer for Hong Kong Institute of Construction (HKIC).

He is member of HKIBIM, HKICBIM and GBIUA. His awarded BIM projects have been selected as Honorable Mention for Autodesk BIM Award 2015, 2016 and 2020.

Nelson had also worked for consultant engineering company for many years and acquired experience in Geotechnical, Civil, Structure of Drafting and BIM projects in projects, including Hong Kong rail projects, T Park, residential estate, hotel projects, Singapore Marina Bay Sands Casino project etc.
