digitalization situation. The speaker foresees that the construction industry currently adopting many different advanced technologies will follow suit. Apparently, ISO19650, a platform/software independent documentation, is a standard for BIM. In fact, it is all about how to create, use, exchange digital data for construction. This international standard inherits UK's terminologies - Project Information and CDE which encourage better exchange of all data related to the project. BIM is supposed to be a good and effective collaboration hub. However, if not handled properly, BIM can become another data silo among others. With well-planned data exchange protocols, the construction industry should be able to break down the silos between BIM and drawings, NEC and EDMS, records and payment, testing and FM. In this seminar, he will share his views on the trend of construction digitalization.
