After a decade in which it was almost a niche topic, the last two years have seen an amazing growth and spread of momentum for the use of OpenBIM in building regulation. Both the post-pandemic increase in digital adoption in institutions and the demands of building sustainability management are driving new or improved Digital Building Permit (DBP) projects in many jurisdictions at local and national levels.
